

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF FIRES, THE SETTING OF FIRES, BURNING OF TRASH OR RUBBISH, RECOVERY OF COSTS, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES AND REMEDIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE Ord. No. 03-005

Section 3. Leaf Burning and Burning of Other Organic Yard Waste

Subject to the provisions of this section, any person, partnership, firm, association, corporation, or any other entity may burn leaves, sticks, twigs, or other similar organic yard waste, subject to the following conditions:

- a. Any such fires can occur only on Friday and Saturday from October 1st through December 1st of the year;
- b. Any burnings must begin after sunrise and be completely extinguished by sunset on those designated days;
- c. All such burnings must be contained or otherwise controlled and shall under no circumstances extend beyond the property owner's parcel onto adjacent parcels or roads. Fires shall be located no less than 25 feet from any building;
- d. All such burnings must be supervised at all times by an adult and never left unattended
