

ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS AND DRAINS, PRIVATE SEWAGE DISPOSAL, ETC. Ord. No. 03-011

Section 3. Minimum monthly charge: There shall be and there is hereby established a minimum charge for the use of and for services supplied by the wastewater facilities of the Village. A minimum basic charge of \$13.50 per month shall be applied to all users whose water consumption does not exceed 2,000 gallons per month.

Section 4. Supplemental service rate: There shall be and there is hereby established an additional charge supplementing the basic minimum rate for the use of and for service supplied by the wastewater facilities of the Village. An additional rate of \$5 per 1,000 gallons shall be applied to all users for water consumption in excess of 2,000 gallons per month. This supplemental service rate shall be computed by the following formula:

$$C = \$13.50 + (5.00 (V - 2,000) / 1,000)$$

Where C = wastewater service charge on a monthly billing basis

V = volume (in gallons) of wastewater discharged during the billing period.

If "V" is equal to or less than 2,000 gallons, the minimum monthly charge will go into effect.

Section 5. Non-metered sewer rates. Except as provided in the special contract between the village users. The rate for non-metered sewer users will be based on the number of occupants of the residence if it is a single family residential establishment.

The rates shall be as follows:

OCCUPANTS / MONTHLY SEWER RATE

1 / \$15.50

2 / \$15.50

3 / \$19.02

4 / \$22.54

5 / \$26.06

Each occupancy above two will be assessed \$3.52 per month. If the Sanitary and Health Committee determines that a significant amount of sewerage above the estimated amount is being discharged, the monthly charge will be adjusted accordingly.

All users, other than single family residential, that are not connected to the Village Water System are required as a condition of hook-up to the sewer system to have a metered water source which complies with Village specification and which is subject to Village inspection.
